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in this multi volume edition the poetry of w b yeats 1865 1939 is presented in full with newly established texts and detailed wide ranging commentary yeats began to write verse in the nineteenth century and over time his own arrangements of poems repeatedly revised and rearranged both texts and canon this edition of yeats s poetry presents all his verse both published and unpublished including a generous selection of textual variants from the many manuscript and printed sources the edition also supplies the most extensive commentary on yeats s poetry to date explaining specific references and setting poems in their contexts it also gives an account of the vast range of both literary and historical influences at work on the verse the poems are presented in order of composition and major revisions or rewritings of poems result in separate inclusions in chronological sequence for these writings as they were subsequently reconceived by the poet in this third volume yeats s poetry of the first decade on the twentieth century is brought into sharp focus revealing the extent of his efforts to re fashion a style that had already made him a well known poet all of the major modes in yeats s earlier work are subject to radical re imagining in these years from poetic narrative founded in irish myth in poems such as baile and aillinn and the old age of queen maeve to the symbolist drama poetry of the shadowy waters here edited in its two completely different

versions of 1900 and 1906 in a decade when the theatre was one of yeats's principal concerns his lyric poems which were becoming increasingly explicit in personal terms began to discover new intensities of conversational pitch and mythic resonance poems such as the folly of being comforted adam's curse no second troy and the fascination of what's difficult are given close attention in this new edition alongside topical and epigrammatic pieces that are often passed over in accounts of yeats's development the evolving complexities of yeats's personal and political lives are crucial to his artistic development in these years and the commentary gives these generous attention showing how the poetry both feeds upon and often transcends the circumstances of its composition the volume offers strong evidence for this decade as a crucial one in yeats's poetic life in which the poet created wholly new registers for his verse as well as new dimensions for his imaginative vision

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includes all the narrative poems that can confidently be assigned to shakespeare

a critical edition of shakespeare's poems venus and adonis lucrece the passionate pilgrim and the phoenix and turtle venus and adonis first published in 1593 is believed to be shakespeare's earliest published work

the poems some of the poetic drama particularly sweeney agonistes and relevant sections of prose criticism are discussed in detail and placed in relation to the development of eliot's oeuvre and more briefly to his life and a wider context of

philosophical and religious enquiry introduction

a theoretical historical and critical inquiry this book looks at the assumptions anthologies are predicated on how they are put together the treatment of the poems in them and the effects their presentations have on their readers

these letters reveal the thoughts of two fine strong minds drawn to each other first by their interest in socialism then by their love of poetry and a similarity of ethics and ideals my mother recognized this in his early prose and poetry they learned so much about each other from these letters yet it seems extraordinary that there was so little personal contact from the introduction by margaret sandburg

this book draws attention to the pervasive artistic rivalry between elizabethan poetry and gardens in order to illustrate the benefits of a trans media approach to the literary culture of the period in its blending of textual studies with discussions of specific historical patches of earth the poem and the garden demonstrates how the fashions that drove poetic invention were as likely to be influenced by a popular print convention or a particular garden experience as they were by the formal genres of the classical poets by moving beyond a strictly verbal approach in its analysis of creative imitation this volume offers new ways of appreciating the kinds of comparative and competitive methods that shaped early modern poetics noting shared patterns both conceptual and material in these two areas not only helps explain the persistence of botanical metaphors in sixteenth century books of poetry but also offers a new perspective on the types of contrastive illusions that distinguish the elizabethan aesthetic with its interdisciplinary approach the poem and the garden is of interest to all students and scholars who study early modern poetics book history and garden studies

this 1999 book offers an original study of lyric form and social custom in the elizabethan age ilona bell explores the tendency of elizabethan love poems not only to represent an amorous thought but to conduct the courtship itself where studies have focused on courtiership patronage and preferment at court her focus is on love poetry amorous courtship and relations between elizabethan men and women the book examines the ways in which the tropes and rhetoric of love poetry were used to court elizabethan women not only at court and in the great houses but in society at large and how the women responded to being wooed in prose poetry and speech bringing together canonical male poets and women writers ilona bell investigates a range of texts addressed to written by read heard or transformed by elizabethan women and charts the beginnings of a female lyric tradition

in tracing george herbert s revisionary goals as they developed through the two manuscripts of the church this book offers a new approach to the interpretation of his poems in showing that herbert intended to encourage his readers to connect the separate lyrics into larger structures of meaning and also to look beyond his poetry to the bible

this book takes a fresh look at the relations between literature and biography by tracing the history of their connections through three hundred years of french literature the starting point for this history is the eighteenth century when the term biography first entered the french language and when the word literature began to acquire its modern sense of writing marked by an aesthetic character arguing that the idea of literature is inherently open to revision and contestation ann jefferson examines the way in which biographically orientated texts have been engaged in questioning and revising definitions of literature at the same time she tracks the evolving forms of biographical writing in french culture and proposes a reappraisal

of biography in terms not only of its forms but also of its functions although ann jefferson s book has powerful theoretical implications for both biography and the literary it is first and foremost a history offering a comprehensive new account of the development of french literature through this dual focus on the question of literature and on the relations between literature and biography it offers original readings of major authors and texts in the light of these concerns beginning with rousseau and ending with life writing contemporary authors such as pierre michon and jacques roubaud other authors discussed include mme de stael victor hugo sainte beuve barbey d aureville baudelaire nerval mallarmé schwob proust gide leiris sartre genet barthes and roger laporte

this edition of charlotte brontë s poems first published in 1985 although not complete provides a reliable text of all of her available verse as well as a detailed history of the whereabouts of charlotte s manuscripts the story of their publication over the years and a commentary of the poetry itself this title will be of interest to students of english literature

in 1995 on the thirtieth anniversary of tanizaki jun ichir 田中 均 s death adriana boscaro organized an international conference in venice that had an unusually lasting effect on the study of this major japanese novelist thanks to boscaro s energetic commitment venice became a center for tanizaki studies that produced two volumes of conference proceedings now considered foundational for all scholarly works on tanizaki in the years before and after the venice conference boscaro and her students published an abundance of works on tanizaki and translations of his writings contributing to his literary success in italy and internationally the grand old man and the great tradition honors boscaro s work by collecting nine essays on tanizaki s position in relation to the great tradition of japanese classical literature to open the collection edward seidensticker contributes a provocative essay on literary styles and the task of translating genji into a modern language gaye rowley and ibuki kazuko also consider tanizaki s genji translations from a completely different point of view documenting the author s three separate translation efforts aileen gatten turns to the influence of heian narrative methods on tanizaki s fiction arguing that his classicism far from being superficial reflects a deep sensitivity to heian narrative tzevetana kristeva holds a different perspective on tanizaki s classicism singling out specific aspects of tanizaki s eroticism as the basis of comparison the next two essays emphasize tanizaki s experimental engagement with the classical literary genres amy v heinrich treats the understudied poetry and bonaventura ruperti considers a 1933 essay on performance arts taking up cinema roberta novelli focuses on the novel manji exploring how it was recast for the screen by masumura yasuz 村松 道雄 the volume concludes with two contributions interpreting tanizaki s works in the light of western and meiji literary traditions paul mccarthy considers nabokovas a point of comparison and jacqueline pigeot conducts a groundbreaking comparison with a novel by natsume s 夏目 漱石

original and engaging this study presents the four anonymous poems found in the cotton nero ms pearl cleanness patience and sir gawain and the green knight as a composite text with a continuous narrative while it is widely accepted that the

poems attributed to the pearl poet ought to be read together this book demonstrates that instead of being analyzed as four distinct though interconnected textual entities they ought to be studied as a single literary unit that produces meaning through its own intricate internal structure piotr spyra defines the epistemological thought of saint augustine as an interpretive key which when applied to the composite text of the manuscript reveals a fabric of thematic continuity this book ultimately provides the reader with a clear sense of the poet s perspective on the nature of human knowledge as well as its moral implications and with a deeper understanding of how the poems bring the theological and philosophical problems of the middle ages to bear on the individual human experience

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
